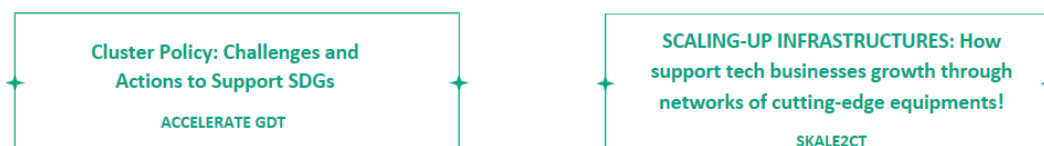

### a ToUR of INnovation ecosystem from start-up to cluster in the framework of the new EU Innovation Agenda



Innovating means introducing new products, services, processes, business models or improving existing ones into the economic system for the first time. The Piedmont region has a long tradition of manufacturing, which has led to the creation of many private companies and start-ups, attracting talented people and providing a rich environment for innovation. To be highly innovative, transformative and competitive, the Piedmont innovation system must become an ecosystem in which sectors and different actors are as integrated and dynamic as possible.

In this framework, the **ACCELERATE GDT** project (of which the Metropolitan City of Turin is a partner) aims to improve actions and policies related to **clusters**, to enhance their capacity to grow and cooperate with SMEs and support their dual green and digital transition.

The **SKALE2CT** project (of which the Metropolitan City of Turin is a partner) on the other hand, focuses on increasing the resources and capacities of public organisations to improve **business acceleration (scale-up)** services, particularly in emerging sectors such as health and digital.

On the basis of a reflection on the local innovation context, the purpose of the event is to make a positive contribution to a strategic reflection aimed at identifying possible key elements for the development of a **more effective and solid innovation ecosystem** in the context of the **European innovation perspective**.

The seminar will bring together personalities active in the metropolitan and regional innovation ecosystem and the partners of the two Interreg projects. The meeting aims to stimulate the **exchange of ideas and good practices**.
